Reduce drug-related threats to national security through military support to federal, state, tribal and local law enforcement and governmental and community partners.

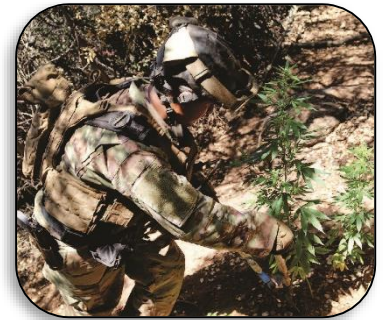
## 54 State Counterdrug Programs
